

Troop 53 Board of Review Checklist
Adopted April 3, 2006

In order to standardize the process for Boards of Review within the troop, the following items are to be assessed:

- 1) The scout meets attendance requirements (50% of scheduled meetings and 1/3 of all other troop or patrol sponsored events)
- 2) The scout presents himself in complete class A uniform to include:
 - a. Class A shirt with all proper badges and epaulettes properly affixed. Proper badges include:
 - i. Twin Rivers Council shoulder patch.
 - ii. Troop 53 sleeve patch.
 - iii. Current rank.
 - iv. Current office, if applicable.
 - v. "Trained" patch (for current office only), if applicable.
 - vi. Universal Scout Emblem.
 - vii. Patrol or Venture Strip patch.
 - viii. No non-approved patches or badges.
 - b. Class A pants with belt
 - c. Neckerchief properly worn
 - d. Proper footwear
 - e. Clean and groomed
- 3) Service hours are complete, Scoutmaster approved, and documented.
- 4) Scout has his Scout Handbook.
- 5) For Star and Life, documentation of completed merit badges.
- 6) For Star and Life, the Board of Review should consider performance in positions of responsibility.
- 7) For all ranks, the Board must assess Scout Spirit, embodied by adherence to the Scout Oath and Law.
